

THE MEANING BEHIND BELIEVER'S BAPTISM...

Have you ever contemplated the incredible value to God of a person following Jesus in believer's baptism? The following are a few of the reasons baptism is so valued by our heavenly Father

1. The symbolism of Jesus' death, burial and resurrection by which he defeated the power of death, hell and the grave. When a new believer is immersed it is symbolic of his/her own death to sin, and release from the penalty of sin. It also symbolizes the new and eternal life which a Christian has in Jesus.
2. Obedience – Commanded by and given as an example that all Christians are to follow. In baptism Jesus was obedient to, and therefore brought honor to His Father.

3. Witness – an unapologetic claim that Jesus is your Savior and that you belong to Him

"If you will confess Me before men, I will confess you before the Father in heaven, but if you will not confess Me before men, I will not confess you before My Father in heaven"

Matthew 10:42

4. Starting point for the believer's ministry... Jesus' Public Ministry began after His baptism. A new believer's baptism is likewise the launching point for his/her service with and to the Lord Jesus

Have you experienced believer's baptism? Baptism is indeed a vital act of obedience, a testimony to others, and a statement of faith in Jesus as your Savior and a pledge of faithfulness to Jesus as your Lord.
