### From my heart to yours...

I also want to ask you to join me in voicing some specific prayer requests to the **LORD**.

- **Thanks** to CCBC members who are continuing faithfully to pray for, attend when possible, and support the ministries of your church!
- 1. Remember what **JESUS** said about us, **HIS** church: "...on this rock I will build My church and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it," Matthew 16:18; and "No one can serve two masters...or else he will be loyal to one and despise the other. You cannot serve GOD and mammon," (worldly possessions), Matthew 6:24.
- 2. Also, hear what Paul taught: "But now GOD has set the members, each one of them, in the body as HE pleased...Now you are the body of CHRIST and members individually," I Corinthians 12:18,
- **Be encouraged** to be the member of *HIS BODY* at CCBC **HE** has called you to be...
- 1. Remember what **JESUS** said: "I will not leave you orphans; I will come to you.," John 14:18; "He who loves his life will lose it, and he who hates his life in this world will keep it unto eternal life. If anyone serves ME, let him follow ME," John 12:25-26; "When the Spirit of truth comes, He will guide you into all truth...'
- 2. What Paul shares in *Philippians 2:12b-13* is very encouraging: "...work out your own salvation with fear and trembling; for it is GOD who works in you both to will and to do for HIS good pleasure."
- Specific prayer requests...
- 1. CCBC members facing significant and critical physical problems, including COVID
- 2. Christians in Afghanistan...They are shutting off cell phones and are going into hiding.

- 3. Christians in China...The Chinese government is offering cash rewards to citizens who will spy on and turn in their Christian neighbors.
- 4. Born-again believers in America to stand strong for the LORD and for HIS church as the American church is experiencing a devastating drop in belief in GOD'S Word

Remember **JESUS** taught us to be *diligent to pray*, to seek the LORD'S will in prayer, and to trust the LORD to provide the very best answer in every situation: Matthew 7:7-11. Paul's words in Philippians 4:6-7 also encourage us to pray consistently: "Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, (humble and earnest request), make your requests be made known to GOD; and the peace of GOD, which surpasses all understanding, will guards your hearts and minds in CHRIST JESUS."

### Can I Be a Prayer Champion, Too?


Yes, every youth has at lease one prayer champion. We want to make sure that each youth has two. I have several students that need a second prayer champion. Please let me know if you are interested.

CCBC Children's Ministry

Little feet will one day make Big footprints.

Parents let me ask you a couple questions, how important is church to you? How important is it to teach children to love the church? The church should be as important to all of us as it is to Jesus. Jesus loves the church completely and was willing to die for it. Not because it is perfect but so it could be perfect. Recently in my quite time I came across this article written by Sarah Bowler, and it was too good not to share.

### Teaching Our Children, the Importance of Church

Author Shane Claiborne has said: "The church is like Noah's ark. It stinks, but if you get out of it, you'll drown."

Simply put, church can get messy. And that's probably part of the reason so many people make excuses for avoiding church—"I'm too busy," "I've been hurt by other Christians," "churches are full of judgmental people," "people are hypocrites or insincere," etc.

We live in a society that increasingly seems to disparage church attendance, a sharp contrast to the psalmist who said, "I was glad when they said to me, let us go into the house of the Lord." Psalm 122:1

Now, going to church, of course, doesn't save us. It's trust in Christ alone that saves. But church is still important for believers, and it's crucial to convey that to our children. Here are some of the reasons why we shouldn't jump off the boat when the going gets tough.

- *Spiritual Gifts*—Several New Testament passages make it clear that every believer receives spiritual gives for the purpose of building up the body of Christ (1 Peter 4:10; 1 Corinthians 12; Romans 12). This can't be done in isolation. The primary place we use our spiritual gifts is in the church serving alongside other believers.
- *The Ordinances*—Jesus Christ established two church ordinances for believers: baptism and the Lord's Supper (Communion). Baptism demonstrates to others our union with Christ, and the Lord's Supper is a form of communion and fellowship with Him. The church carries out these practices.
- *Hearing the Word of God*—While we can and should read the Bible on our own throughout the week, setting aside a time each week to hear the Word of God emphasizes its importance in our lives and helps us grow in our spiritual walk. Romans 10:17 says, "So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God."
- Accountability—God put in place spiritual leaders to act as overseers and shepherds of His flock, and He commands us to submit to those in authority so long as they are not leading us into sin or asking us to do something contrary to the Word of God (Hebrews 13:17; 1 Peter 5:1–4). It's hard to submit to our spiritual leaders unless we regularly are involved with an organized body of believers. Further, when a believer isolates himself, it often becomes easier to hide or rationalize sin. We need to help each other pursue paths of Holiness. Galatians 6:1 urges us, "Brethren if a man is overtaken in any trespass, you who are spiritual restore such a one in a spirit of gentleness, considering yourself lest you also be tempted."
- Serving One Another—Many passages in the New Testament give "one another" commands: "wash one another's feet" (John 13:14), "love one another" (John 13:34), "encourage one another" (1 Thessalonians 4:18; 5:11), "confess your sins to one another" (James 5:16), "pray for one another" (James 5:16). Going to church should be about more than meeting our individual needs; it's about serving others.
- *The Great Commission*—We can share the gospel anywhere, but the church is one of the primary modes God has established for taking the gospel message to the world. The Great Commission specifically commands believers to make and baptize disciples, something you'd be hard pressed to do without a church.

### Family Discussion Questions

At some point, as our children grow up, it's helpful to talk about why we attend church. Here are a few questions to ask:

- Why do you think it matters that Christians attend church consistently?
- What factors are important in choosing a church?
- What is the spiritual significance of each part of the church service (musical worship, communion, tithing, the sermon, etc.)?
- How can your spiritual gifts be utilized?
- How do you think the local church can best carry out the Great Commission? *Article Written by Sarah Bowler*
