



From my heart to yours...

IT'S A MIRACLE! How many times have you heard that? Many I am sure, and most of the time when focus is given to the word MIRACLE, the first thing that comes to mind is a "back to life from death" experience like Lazarus. It might be a near miss accident, which was seemingly impossible to avoid, or the reconciliation of a rift between relatives or friends might also be spoken of as a miracle. There are many others of course, yet we all agree the greatest MIRACLE of all is the spiritual rebirth of a person's sin-stained soul, a soul that was previously bound for the darkness of separation from GOD and the torturous flames of an eternal hell, but praise the LORD, a soul redeemed through faith in Jesus which has become a heaven-bound saint of GOD! WOW! Now that is a MIRACLE, and I pray that you have experienced that exact MIRACLE from GOD! Consider this question: Besides that greatest of all MIRACLES, is there an event you have seen or been part of that could be placed in the realm of the miraculous? <u>WEEK!</u> I hope what <u>GOD</u> did for me will encourage you to be looking for the next <u>miracle HE</u> wants to bless you to observe, to receive, or even to be for someone else.

• MIRACLE #1 - For over two years I have been trying to locate a friend who is MY ONE whom GOD placed on my heart to pray for and share the LORD with. On Tuesday I was in the doctor's office, and J.C., MY ONE, walks in. We catch up a bit and share phone numbers. You might ask, "WHERE'S THE MIRACLE"? Multiply that by our appointments being at the exact same time in the same doctor's office, (and I was a "work-in" patient from a call I made the previous day). There are not enough zeroes to represent those odds being met. Yet, the greatest reason this is a

MIRACLE is that *GOD* graciously, in *HIS* perfect timing, brought us together, allowing us to reconnect for *HIS OWN* perfect purposes yet to be revealed! **WOW!**

MIRACLE #2 - Many CCBC folks have had various doses of illnesses in the past few weeks, months, and even years. I have been in that group for a short time. This past Wednesday morning, I got up at 6:00 and had a sense of being overwhelmed with many things, including all that had to be done before Sunday. I have to admit that I was at a low ebb emotionally. At 6:30, I suddenly felt an incredible, out-of-the-blue sense of peace come over me. At 6:45, I got a text from Evangelist Johnny Tucker saying that I had just been prayed for. WOW! GOD'S grace had filled me with HIS peace because a brother in *CHRIST* hundreds of miles away had been led by *GOD'S HOLY SPIRIT* to pray specifically for me! GOD knows all our needs and will use other willing souls as HIS channels of blessing for us. HE will also use us, you, and me if we are willing, to be channels of HIS blessing for others.

TO SUM IT UP...

• First, look around for your "buttercup" miracles. They will erect an impenetrable wall of GOD'S peace around your soul when life gets tough or even when events seem like a "Ten-on-the-Richter-Scale -Earthquake" that is about to swallow you alive.

Next, please be a praying believer and believe as you pray. GOD may well use your prayers as someone's "buttercup" miracle to shower HIS incredible miraculous gift of peace upon that someone for

whom you pray.

• Finally, let us Praise GOD from WHOM all blessings flow! HE is faithful! And I pray HE will keep me, and HE will keep you faithful also, so that when we stand before the LORD on judgment day, we will hear HIM say, "Well done good and faithful servant...enter into the joy of thy Lord." 



Missing The Mark

Romans 3:23 For all have sinned and come short of the glory of God;

During the 2004 Olympics, archer Matt Emmons was one shot away from a gold medal. He was competing in the 50-meter three position rifle event, and he was in perfect position to claim victory. He didn't even need a bullseye; all he needed to do to win was to hit the target to win the gold. Standing in lane two, Emmons took a shot and nailed it. However, he hit the target in the third lane. He hit the wrong target. He missed his mark. As a result, he received zero points and landed in eighth place. You see, like Emmons, we all have "fallen short of the glory of God". We have all missed the mark from time to time.

We were created in the image of God (Genesis 1:26-27). Yet, from the time Adam & Eve sinned (Genesis 3), we have fallen far short of God's glory. Doing good works is honorable, but not good enough when God expects, and demands, perfection. The righteousness of God is demonstrated throughout the Scripture. Yet, because of the corrupting presence of sin, we have fallen far short of His righteousness and His glory.

Every person born into the human race since the fall has been under a death sentence. No matter how good or moral a person may be, "all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God" (Romans 3:23). And "the wages of sin is death" (Romans 6:23). We needed deliverance from death, but our righteousness could never be equal to the task. The best person, no matter how hard he or she tries, will still come short of the glory of God. Someone may say, "I'm as good as any person who goes to your church." That may be true, but God doesn't grade "on the curve"; He demands 100% righteousness. True, some come closer than others, but all will come short.

But in the midst of our imperfections, weaknesses and fatal mistakes stands a Savior who reminds us of His righteousness. We do not have to be perfect because He is perfect. Our standing is in Christ; therefore, we must stand in Him. Through Him we become the righteousness of God. I do not have to always be "on target" because through Him I have already won the gold.

Jesus being perfect and sinless had nothing for which to atone, so His perfect righteousness was available to be our deliverance. He did not just cover our sins, but He removed them and replaced them with His righteousness so that we could be delivered from death. What a wonderful truth! That Jesus would actually bare your sins upon His own body and suffer the crucifixion for you. You will stand before God as though you have never sinned, not because of your sinless, but because of Christ's righteousness.

We had a debt that we owed to God that we could not pay (Romans 5:12). Jesus who knew no sin became as sin that we who knew no righteousness could be made the righteousness of God in Christ (II Corinthians 5:21). Jesus placed all of His righteousness upon my record so that I might be viewed by God as having the righteousness of Christ. Now that's a loving God! Do you realize all that you will miss if you reject Jesus as your Savior?
