From my heart to yours...

RESURRECTION DAY IS SOON! Are you excited? I certainly am, and as you and I contemplate Resurrection Day 2022, I invite you to take a few minutes to read the following about Christ's passion for you and me. I have no doubt this pre-Easter Sunday "journey" will heighten your love and appreciation for Christ's sacrifice for you on the cross. He paid the price necessary to redeem you! He ransomed your eternal soul out of an eternal hell when you believed and received God's grace, the greatest gift ever! **If you are excited, READ ON!**

"Father, forgive them they do not know what they do" ... Luke 23:34 Jesus died a gruesome torturous death, and yet he asked that His murderers be forgiven. That plea was also for you, for me, indeed for all humanity. **ARE YOU EXCITED?**

"Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani? My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?" Matthew 27:46 Jesus' cry of forsakenness was because He had become sin for us that we might become the righteousness of God through Him (see **2 Corinthians 5:21**). His cry was also because the Father had turned His back on Jesus (see **Habakkuk 1:13**). Jesus, on the cross, bore the physical agony, the emotional fear, and the spiritual horror of separation from God we would have experienced as He took them all upon Himself, for you. **ARE YOU EXCITED?**

"Assuredly I say to you, today you will be with Me in paradise." Luke 23:43 Jesus made this promise to the penitent sinner who was on the cross beside Him, the man had acknowledged his sin and worthiness of death. He defended Jesus' innocence. He then asked Jesus to remember him when He came into His kingdom. Jesus assured him He would! When you came to Jesus, believing Him to be the one and only way to be forgiven and that His forgiveness provides escape from hell and an eternal residence in heaven, He made you the same promise about the day you leave this world. **ARE YOU EXCITED?**

"Father, into Thy hands I commend my Spirit." Luke 23:46 Here, Jesus displayed complete trust in God His Father to receive Him back into the eternal glory he had shared with the Father from before time. Though Jesus was sinless, do not forget that He had become sin for us and bore our sin on the cross. And once our debt of sin was paid by Jesus, He knew the Father would turn His Holy Face back to Him and would receive Him again into that eternal glory. When you trusted Jesus as Savior and became a born-again believer, you too can totally trust God to also receive you. **ARE YOU EXCITED?**

"IT IS FINISHED!" John 19:23

Just before Jesus breathed His last breath, He acknowledged to God that the task for which He had come to earth had been completed—Sin and death were defeated! Heaven's gates were opened wide! And anyone who calls on the name of Jesus as Savior (see **Acts 4:12**) and are born-again through faith in Jesus (see **Ephesians 2:8-9**) becomes a new spiritual creation (see **2 Corinthians 5:17**). And, to the praise and glory of God, you are given a new purpose for living (see **Ephesians 2:10**). **ARE YOU EXCITED?**

THE VEIL IN THE TEMPLE WAS RIPPED!

"And Jesus cried out with a loud voice and breathed His last. Then the veil of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom. So, when the centurion who was opposite Him, saw that he cried out like this and breathed His last, he said, 'Truly this man was the Son of God.'" Mark 15:37-39. Religious scholars say that it took 300 priests to carry this sixty-foot tall, forty-foot wide, four-inch-thick curtain that separated the Holy of Holies from the outside world. Only the High Priest was allowed to enter this inner sanctum of the temple once a year at Passover to make atonement for the sins of the people. What no human hands could possibly do, God did through the death of His Son. When Jesus paid the sin debt of mankind, God tore apart this physical barrier to Himself as Jesus, through His death made salvation available for all who become born-again through faith in Him. All who are saved and have a holy relationship with Jesus and God of which Jesus says, **"and they shall never perish"** (see **John 10:27-30**). **WHAT IS THE MESSAGE OF THE TORN CURTAIN?** Know Jesus as your Savior, and the barrier to God's eternal glory is gone, forever! **ARE YOU EXCITED?**

RESURRECTION DAY 2022 IS SOON! Are you grateful? Are you excited?

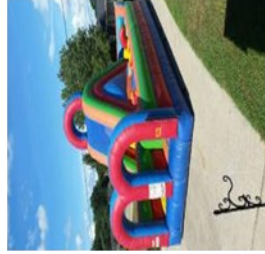


Family fun for all!
