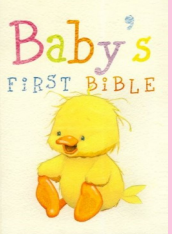

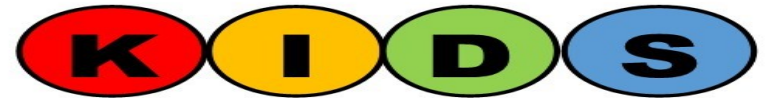

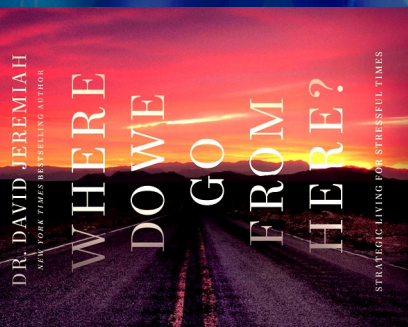

A frequent speaker at churches and conventions, Hunt brings Baptist history alive, speaking on remarkable figures from the past. She also inspires with her dramatic monologues of Lottie Moon, Hephzibah Jenkins Townsend, Kathleen Mallory, and Ann Judson.
