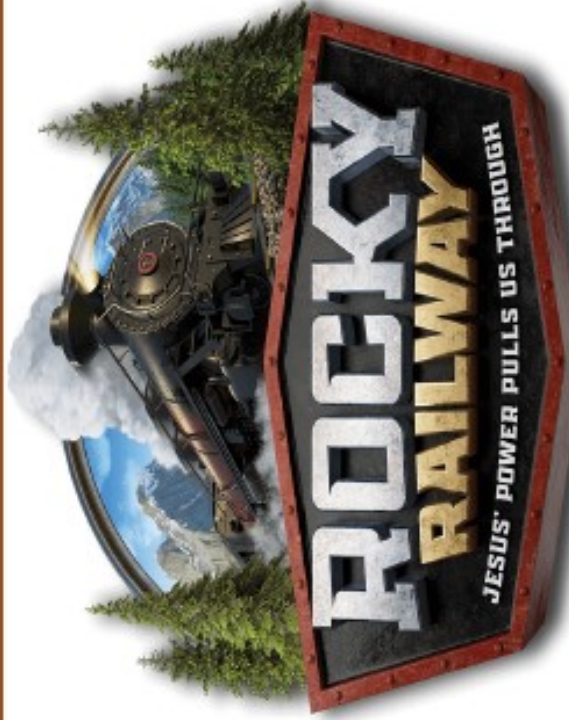

A Ministry For and With Those 18-25 Years of Age

Joseph was chosen by God while still a child living at home. Before he was grown, his eleven jealous brothers sold him into slavery. While serving in Potiphar's house, Joseph was wrongly accused of rape and spent the next thirteen years in prison. A fellow inmate told Joseph that when he got out, he would plead for Joseph's release. But he forgot his pledge. Not fair!

Living and working in a dream environment is a goal for most of us. But when the dream turns into a toxic nightmare and life seems unfair, how do we climb out of bed every morning and make ourselves face the day?

Colossians 3:23 says "Whatever you do, work heartily, as for the Lord and not for men".

What does this verse tell us? How can we apply it to our everyday life?

"Whatever you do, do it with all of your heart..." This line tells us to not just do something for the sake of doing it, or not just doing something to get it done and check it off of a list. It tells us that whatever we do, we need to do our best at it and give it our best effort. We need to put our heart into it. "...as doing it for the Lord, not for man." To us, this says that our aim should be to please God, not man (or woman). We should do things because God wants us to, not because people want us to. We need to treat every situation with great care and do it to the best of our ability as if we were doing it for the Lord, not for another person. When we start to do this, people will notice there is something different about us and the way we treat others and act. What a great way to witness to others! Our actions speak so loudly about what is in our heart.

Joseph faced many unfair and difficult times in his life, but he always worked to honor God in all he did. Because Joseph strived to always honor God in all that he did, God blessed him. Let's follow Joseph's example and strive every day to please God and not mankind.
