

Lord I Am Konfused

There was a man who one day went about his business wearing a big badge with four letters: they were B.A.I.K. People were obviously curious about what he was up to, so one person asked, What do the letters stand for? His answer: It means Boy Am I Confused.

His friend was puzzled: But why do you spell the word 'confused' with a 'k'? The man replied well, that shows you how confused I am.

In times of confusion, it is important to maintain our faith and be obedient. Although we may not understand certain things in the present confusion, if we remain faithful and obedient, confusion will lift, and clarity will come in time.

I define faith in practical terms by saying that faith is acting like God is telling the truth. Your faith must always be directly tied to an action done in response to a revealed truth—otherwise it is not faith. If you are not willing to do something in response to it, even if that something is as small as simply being still in your soul rather than worrying, then the faith you claim to have is not real. Faith always involves your walk not just your talk. Keep in mind it is not just faith in anything at all. It must be faith in God's truth.

For example, if faith is tied to your feelings—how much faith you feel—that faith will be empty. You might feel entirely full of faith but not follow up with actions because you really don't believe in what you say you feel. Faith is always based on your feet—what you do in response to what you believe. Faith is a function of the mind that shows up in your choices and responses to life.

Our church was dealt a blow when the prospective pastor removed his name from consideration. Many thought this was the man God was sending to lead Carrolls Creek Baptist Church.

We say we have faith that God is in control and has a plan for our church. CCBC, now is the time we need to show our faith is more than just a saying or feeling. Now is the time we need to come together as a church and put feet to our faith. I believe the following things can help us get started. The list below is not an all inclusive list but if we will be faithful to do the small things, in time, God will clear the confusion and the man that God has chosen to lead CCBC will become crystal clear.

- 1. Pray for the search committee as they start over. Pray for the man God has preordained to lead CCBC. We may not know his name yet but God does.
- 2. Look for ways to serve in the church and support the ministries of the church. We cannot get caught up in the sin of inactivity by always saying we will wait until we hire a pastor. We don't have to wait on a new pastor to be about God's work.
- 3. Support God's church with your tithes and offerings.
- 4. Keep an open mind to what God is wanting to accomplish in and through CCBC.
- 5. Pray some more (Pray without ceasing. 1 Thessalonians 5:17).

I love Carrolls Creek Baptist Church and the people who worship and serve here. I am excited for the what God wants to do here. We need to continue to trust God and actively show the world CCBC is "A Loving Church".


