





Curiosity

"Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives, and the one who seeks finds, and to the one who knocks it will be opened. Or which one of you, if his son asks him for bread, will give him a stone? Or if he asks for a fish, will give him a serpent? If you then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give good things to those who ask him Matthew 7:7-11

Albert Einstein, the physicist who developed the theory of relativity, once said, "The important thing is not to stop questioning. Curiosity has its own reason for existing. One cannot help but to be in awe when he contemplates the mysteries of eternity, of life, of the marvelous structure of reality. It is enough if one tries merely to comprehend a little of this mystery every day."

Most of us are not on a quest to discover the laws governing the universe like Einstein was. Perhaps our questions are more along the lines of "What brewing process makes the best cup of coffee?" or "What's for lunch?" Maybe some of us have stopped asking deeper questions of our lives altogether. We keep our curiosity to a minimum so we can stay in our comfort zone.

Give yourself permission to be curious. Chase ideas that may challenge you, excite you, and even overturn your predictable existence. Asking questions—and then staying with them until the answers arrive—makes all the difference in how your life, your career, and your relationships work.

At its center, curiosity has three main questions:

- Why Not?
- What Would?
- When Will?

Let me ask you a question. When was the last time you were curious about God and His plans for your life. The scripture above says to ask, and it will be given to you. Seek and you will find. During the month of May, I challenge you to ask yourself the three questions below and see what God reveals to you.

- Why Not? What has God laid on your heart that you have said no to—without first asking yourself, why in the world not?
- What Would? Write down what it would look like if you finally surrendered to the call God has for your life.
- When Will? Take out your planner, or open up your calendar, and answer the question when will I start using my talents for God?

CCBC lets show our curiosity towards God and His plans for our church. Let's have the mindset of why not CCBC. What would this community be like if CCBC was the church God has caller her to be? CCBC, when will start our mission?
