A Ministry For and With Those 18-25 Years of Age



I Trust You God, But...

Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. Philippians 4:6-7

I recently read a book that had a chapter dedicated to the subject of worry in a Christian's life. What follows is an overview of that chapter.

It happened again. We have all been there. We try not to look at the clock, but every so often we just cannot resist: 1:00 a.m. We calculate in our minds precisely how much sleep we would get if we fell asleep right now. What seems like a few minutes later, a glance again: 2:30 a.m. We calculate again how much sleep we would get if we fell asleep right now.

I wish I could tell you that most of us were laying there in bed praying, meditating on scripture, or simply basking in God's presence. But we are not. We are laying there tossing, turning, sweating drenched in worry.

We know we're not supposed to worry. We try not to worry, but sometimes it's hard. Worrying is bad for our health. In fact, our word worry derives from the German word *wurgen*, which literally means "to strangle, constrict, or choke." That sounds like worry feels, doesn't it?

Many of us try to minimize worry or we use different euphemisms to mask it: "I'm concerned about something." "I have some issues I'm working through." or "I have something on my mind."

No matter what you call it, worry is sin. In Philippians 4:6, Paul tells us not to be anxious about anything. Romans 14:23 says, "Everything that does not come from faith is sin." That's pretty clear. Worry is the opposite of faith therefore, it's sin. Worry, in essence, is the sin of distrusting the promises and power of God. Worry indicates we're not willing to let God handle certain things—at least not in His way, and certainly not in His time.

So how do we start to gain freedom from worry? First, we must turn to the Word of God. Philippians 4:6-7 tells us, "Don't worry about anything." And it doesn't just tell us what not to do. It tells us what to do as well. "Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and thank Him for all He has done. If we do this, we will experience God's peace, which is far more wonderful than the mind can understand. His peace will guard our hearts and minds as we live in Christ Jesus. Worry then becomes a signal alerting us that it's time to pray.

Second, we must learn to trust God's plan and His timing. God is far more patient than we are. He has eternity, so He's in no hurry. Listen to His promise: "I know the plans I have for you, declares the Lord, plans to prosper and not to harm you, plans to give you a hope and a future. We must learn to trust God even if the His plan and timing isn't the one we would choose.

It won't be easy to overcome worry, but once you have walked with God and experienced His faithfulness time and again, you can actually stop worrying.

I challenge you to live in God's promises and in a way that demonstrates your confidence in Him. After all, He is wise, He is willing, and He is able to free us from worry.
