Would Anyone Even Notice?

For God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through Him. John 3:16-17

On Sunday, August 11th @ 5:30 pm in the sanctuary, Bro. Chad will be leading a new Bible study entitled "*Know What You're For*".

In our world today, people are often known more for what they are against than what they are for. Unfortunately, this extends even into the church. We want to reach the lost with the incredibly good news of Christ, but often all they ever hear us emphasize are the behaviors and attitudes we are against. In this video Bible study, pastor Jeff Henderson points out God is **FOR** the people in our world. He is **FOR** breaking down unnecessary barriers that keep people away from experiencing His love. As His church, we are called to be **FOR** the people we live with, go to school with, work with, play with, do business with, in other words we are supposed to be for to be **FOR** the community around us?

Recently I read the book that goes along with the Bible study. In the book, pastor Jeff asked a very humbling question, "If your church were to close its doors for good, would anybody in your community even notice?" I don't know about you, but to me that question hurt. Here at CCBC we call ourselves "*The Loving Church*", but are we showing our community we are **FOR** them and are we loving them the way God has called us to love them?

The word *for* means to be in favor of, or in support of. The verses above tell us that God is for and in support of the people He created. He showed just how much He is for the world when He gave and sent His most valuable possession to be the payment for our sin debt. Churches can too often focus on what happens inside the walls while rarely looking out into the community. It's why we must move beyond the boundaries of our church walls and interact with our community. I once read a quote that says, "People don't care how much you know until they know how much you care." In others words, our community has to know we are for them. Once we do that it gives us an opportunity to share with how God is for them and loves them and wants an eternal relationship with them.

There is too much information in the powerful study to share in this limited space. So, I want to personally invite you to come join us as Bro. Chad leads us through this Bible study and as we begin to talk about ways, we can show our community we are For them and through that support we can carry the message of Jesus Christ to a hurting world. Will you join us in being **FOR** our community?


