## **The Great Commission**

While there are many challenges in reaching the unreached world with the gospel, the real challenge is for us to understand the Great Commission and our response in obedience to do what Jesus commissioned us to do.

When asked if they had previously "heard of the Great Commission," half of U.S. churchgoers (51%) say they do not know this term. It would be reassuring to assume that the other half who know the term are also actually familiar with the passage known by this name, but that proportion is low (17%). Meanwhile, "the Great Commission" does ring a bell for one in four (25%), though they can't remember what it is. Seven percent of churchgoers are simply not sure whether they have heard this term "the Great Commission" before.

What is a commission? Merriam-Webster defines commission as this: a task or matter entrusted to one as the agent for another. Jesus's final command to his followers is to go out and tell others the good news of his life, death, and resurrection. These are the instructions that he left for us as we wait for his triumphant return. This seems completely overwhelming. To think about being an agent for Jesus' message on earth feels like it is something beyond what we could accomplish. But Jesus did not ascend into Heaven and leave us alone here to figure it out. Jesus says that he is with us always.

God has given us his Holy Spirit. Acts 1:8 says: "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." The Holy Spirit gives us power and confidence so that we can proclaim Jesus' message.

God also has given us his church. The body of believers around us can help support us and provide comfort as we go forward to tell others about Jesus. I feel so much better about this commission knowing that I do not have to do it alone.

Let the Holy Spirit guide you. 2 Corinthians 3:18 says: "And we, who with unveiled faces all reflect the Lord's glory, are being transformed into his likeness with everincreasing glory, which comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit." Let the Holy Spirit transform you to be more like Christ so that you may be better able to fulfill this great commission we have been given. Connect to the body of Christ, the church, so that you have support as you fulfill this mission from God.
