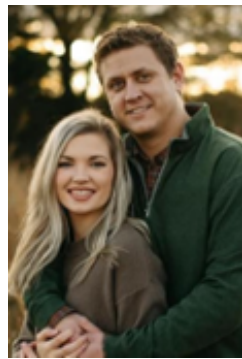

“Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Ghost; as it was in the beginning, is now and ever shall be, world without end. Amen, amen.”

You might be familiar with this ancient hymn known by the Latin, Gloria Patri. If you’re not, that’s okay, you’re probably in the majority. While it’s brief like the Doxology, Gloria Patri carries substantial theological weight. It has certainly been an encouragement to me, and I pray that it encourages you as well.

The first part of the hymn reminds Christians of what sets us apart from every other religion: belief in the Triune God. God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit are one divine essence in three distinct persons.

The second part reminds us that from the very beginning of time God had Easter on His mind. Jesus coming to save mankind was not an afterthought, but “as it was at the beginning,” it was the very heartbeat of God. During the Easter season as we reflect on the resurrected Christ, we can boast that an empty grave proves that Jesus is exactly who He said that He was – the Son of God who came to take away the sins of the world. We can find peace knowing that the God who created the universe loves us so much that He took on flesh, became like us, and died for our sins. We can boast that an empty grave proves that when we die, we can beat death forever because we belong to the One who has already beaten death and the grave, and for all eternity we will give glory to the Triune God.

You have been given the gift of life. Make it count by bringing glory to God every chance you get. How can you glorify God? By loving Him with all of your heart, soul, mind, and strength and doing what he commands. Submit to Jesus as Lord, repent of sin, come to church, serve, tell others about Jesus, read God’s Word, pray, and live your life in constant worship of the Triune God who loves you.

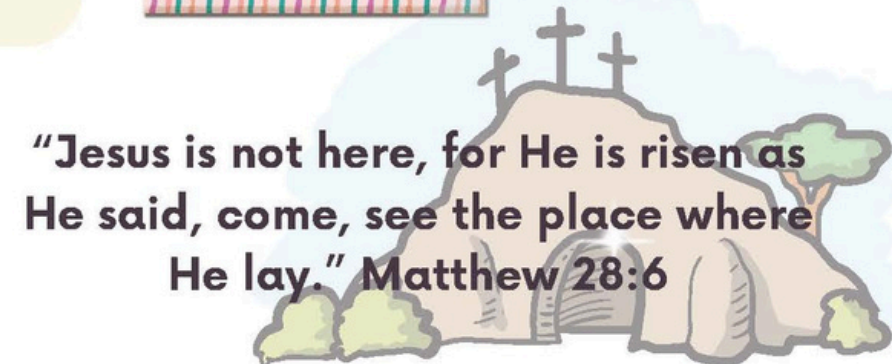
