Tithing in the Old Testament

II Chronicles 29, 30, 31

- ❖ *GOD made it clear that a **Proportion** was to be devoted.*
- ❖ *Jesus' death became the last **Sacrifice**.*
- ❖ *Jesus' resurrection day replaced the **Sabbath**.*
- ❖ *God's word never abolished or replaced the **Tithe**.*



Tithing in the Old Testament

II Chronicles 29, 20, 31

- ❖ **Abraham** gave the tithe to Melchizedek, Genesis 14:20.
- ❖ **Jacob** promised the tithe to God, Genesis 28:19-22.
- ❖ **Mosaic Law** – God called the tithe holy, Leviticus 27:30.
- ❖ **Heaven Sent Revival** – 2 Chronicles 30:1
- ❖ **God Delivers Israel** – 2 Chronicles 32: 1, 7-8



Ancient Israel & 21st Century Giving

- ❖ Principle of **Tithing** – “You ought to...”
Matthew 23:23
- ❖ Principle of meeting **Daily Needs** – “A dispute arose...” Acts 6
- ❖ Principle for **Clergy** – 1 Corinthians 9: 13,14

1 Corinthians 16:1-2
